

Outpatient operations

If you will be undergoing the operation as an outpatient, you must please observe the following code of behaviour:

- You will be **discharged** between two and four hours after the end of the operation, depending on your condition and the operation performed.
- **Leaving the hospital:**
You must make your way home **accompanied by another person and under no circumstances as an active road user!** Please arrange to be collected from the hospital by an accompanying adult. Ensure that you will have a **constant carer at home for the subsequent 24 hours**. If you are unable to arrange a person to look after you will have to stay overnight as a clinic inpatient.
- **For a period of 24 hours, you must not do the following:**
Be an active road user (neither with a car or bicycle)
Operate machinery
Make important decisions
- Additional medications: Only to be taken if instructed to do so by a doctor.
